NOTICE TO THE VOTERS OF THE 1st PRECINCT OF THE CAERNARVON TOWNSHIP, BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

The Berks County Board of Elections has filed with the Court of Common Pleas, Criminal Division of Berks County, Pennsylvania, a Petition recommending that the 1st Precinct of the Caernarvon Township, Berks County, Pennsylvania, which currently has **2,212** registered voters, be divided into two precincts.

The hearing of the Petition of the Berks County Board of Elections will be held on **Tuesday, July 22, 2008 at 1:30 p.m.** in the Courtroom of Judge Scott E. Lash, 633 Court Street, Reading, Pennsylvania.

If the Court approves said division of the 1st Precinct, there will be **1,154** registered voters in the 1st Precinct and **1,123** registered voters in the new 2nd Precinct.

Any person objecting to the said division of 1st Precinct of the Caernarvon Township shall state their objections in writing and file the same with the Clerk of the Courts of Common Pleas, Criminal Division, 4th Floor, Berks County Courthouse, Reading, Pennsylvania on or before July 22, 2008, at 1:30 p.m.
