EMERGENCY MEETING MINUTES**

May 28, 2019

The Caernarvon Township Board of Supervisors held an Emergency Meeting on May 28, 2019 in the Twin Valley Elementary Center located at 50 Mast Drive, Elverson, PA pursuant to notice according to law.

This meeting constitutes an “Emergency Meeting” as defined by the Sunshine Law. The meeting was convened without public notice for the purpose of dealing with an emergency involving a clear and present danger to life and property in the immediate aftermath of a destructive tornado within the township and during the pendency of further severe thunderstorm warnings.

CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Allen Styer called the meeting to order at 8:45 PM. This was followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

BUSINESS

- A. Emergency Assistance – Red Cross has staged at the Twin Valley Fire Company and the Social Hall is open for shelter.
- B. Township Emergency Declaration. All attending Supervisors voted in favor.
- C. Berks and Chester Emergency Services notified about Emergency Declaration.
- D. The Supervisors decided to let Red Cross take the lead on displaced families.

REPORTS

- A. Injuries Report - Fire Department Chief reported no injuries.
- B. Affected Areas – Mast Road, Industrial Park, Main Street and Valley Ponds. Valley Ponds hit the worst.

ADJOURNMENT

Sandy Styer made a motion to adjourn meeting. Jeff Vickers seconded motion. Motion carried unanimously. Meeting adjourned at 8:53PM.
